**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING BARANGAY WATERWORKS MAINTENANCE
SUBSIDY TO THE TWELVE (12) NON-CENTRAL BARANGAYS OF BONTOC AND
ITS AUTOMATIC APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Municipality of Bontoc is composed of Sixteen (16) barangays. Out of the 16 barangays the local government unit of Bontoc maintained and served only four (4) central barangays of Samoki, Caluttit, Poblacion and Bontoc Ili of their waterworks maintenance. At this point, the 12 barangays were not served or shall we say neglected, yet a part and parcel of Bontoc ay Kalalaychan. They are a people and they would like also to share from the bounties of the municipal government. It should served the constituents equally, just and fair just like a good father of a family.

We believe that water is life, it being so, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bontoc assembled that:

Section 1. Title – Waterworks barangay maintenance fund subsidy of the municipality of Bontoc.


Section 11 – Declaration of Policy – It is hereby declared a policy of the Local Government Unit to govern and served all its component barangays equally in the delivery of basic services as stated in Section 16 the General Welfare Clause of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.


Section 111 – Barangay Waterworks Maintenance Subsidy – It is hereby mandated that the Municipal Government of Bontoc shall provide yearly Waterworks maintenance subsidy of the twelve (12) barangays in the amount of THREE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P 360,000.00) to be allocated equally to the twelve barangays. It is further declared that the said amount of three hundred sixty pesos (P 360,000.00) shall be remitted to the barangays in a quarterly manner and should not be withheld by the Local Government Unit/municipal treasurer for any reasons of barangay accountability.

Section IV – Separability Clause: the parts or provisions of this ordinance are separable. Any part or provisions hereof that maybe invalidated by competent authority shall not invalidate the other parts or provisions hereof not so invalidated and the same remain in full effect.

Section V – Effectivity clause: This Ordinance takes effect 10 days after publication in the bulletin board of the municipal hall and other available posting areas.






