ORDINANCE NO. 266, S. 2015

AN ORDINANCE PARTIALLY AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 256, S. 2015, OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.

Whereas, this Body enacted Municipal Ordinance No. 256, S. 2015 bearing title: **AN ORDINANCE REALIGNING/REAPPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P1,500,000.00) FROM ITEM NO. 9000 (PURCHASE OF LANDFILL) OF THE CY MUNICIPAL AIP 2015 TO OTHER MUNICIPAL PROGRAMS OF THIS MUNICIPALITY;**

Whereas, said Ordinance specifically realigned/reappropriated the said amount for: (1) Construction of Access Road at Am-anchu to the LGU property (General Waste Processing Facility); and (2) Purchase of Additional lot adjacent to the General Waste Processing Facility of the Municipal Government for use in the construction of the access road to the LGU property (General Waste Processing Facility);

Whereas, and as of the moment, the road from the municipal road up to the Am-anchu LGU Property had already been constructed/cleared/opened, however the same has not yet been concreted as of the moment;


Whereas, the need to concretize said road becomes imperative if the development of the LGU Property and its usage for the purpose it was purchased should be fastracked and considering the onset of the rainy season;

Whereas, this Municipal Government intends to use the amount of TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP200, 000.00) appropriated under Municipal Ordinance No. 256, S. 2015 for the purchase of additional lot adjacent to the General Waste Processing Facility of the Municipal Government for use in the construction of the access road to the LGU property, to completely concrete the said road leading to the latter; and

WHEREFOREAND FOREGOING CONSIDERED, this August Body hereto decrees the following, viz-

Section 1. – Section 1 of Municipal Ordinance No. 256, S. 2015, which states-

“SECTION 1- FUND REALIGNMENT/REAPPROPRIATIONS- The amount of P1,500,000.00 from item No. 9000 of CY Municipal AIP are hereby realigned/reappropriated to
wit:



1. Construction of Access Road at Am-anchu to the LGU Property (General Waste Processing Facility) – P1,300,000.00;
2. Purchase of additional lot adjacent to the General Waste Processing Facility of the Municipal Government for use in the construction of the access road to the LGU Property (General Waste Processing Facility) – P200,000.00.”

-is hereto AMENDED/MODIFIED to read as follows-

“SECTION 1- FUND REALIGNMENT/REAPPROPRIATIONS- The amount of P1,500,000.00 from item No. 9000 of CY Municipal AIP are hereby realigned/reappropriated to wit:

1. Construction of Access Road at Am-anchu to the LGU Property (General Waste Processing Facility) – P1,300,000.00;
2. Concreting of Am-anchu Access Road – P200,000.00.”

Section 2. Conditions- The implementation and disbursement of the renamed/reappropriated amount under the amended Section 1, supra, shall be made strictly for the purpose for which it is appropriated for. Further, the Municipality shall comply with the existing state auditing, budgeting and accounting rules and regulations;











Section 3. Repealing Clause- The pertinent portions of the CY 2015 Municipal AIP, its supporting documents as well as the amended portion of Ordinance No. 256, S. 2015 are hereby amended/modified/repealed accordingly;

Section 4. Separability Clause- Only those part/s of this Ordinance so declared invalid by competent authority shall be so without any effect on the other parts not declared void;

Section 5. Effectivity- This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Chief Executive.
