**AN ORDINANCE OPENING FIFTY (50) ADDITIONAL TRICYCLE FRANCHISES FOR THE
MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.**

PREFATORY

WHEREAS, and as a necessary consequence of the growth of the Municipality's population, there is noted need to increase the existing number of tricycle franchises, to sufficiently serve the basic transportation needs of this sector of society;

WHEREFORE, and with the end in view of attaining sufficient tricycle transportation service vis-à-vis the number of the riding public to be served, this August Body in this meeting duly assembled, NOW THEREFORE DECREE the following, viz:

Section 1. Opening – In addition to those already existing prior to the effectivity of this Ordinance, there is hereto opened/created fifty (50) new tricycle franchises for this Municipality.

Section 2. Authority of the Municipal Tricycle Franchising and Regulatory Board (MTFRB) – The MTFRB is hereto given the task of overseeing the disposition of these newly opened franchises. Corollary to this, the MTFRB being in the best position to know, shall, upon effectivity of this Ordinance, promulgate its guidelines in the disposition of these franchises, which shall include such requirements needed before issuance of a franchise, limitations on the maximum number of franchises which can be given to an applicant/operator, as well as other matters as may aid in the prompt and fair distribution of said franchises.

Section 3. Separability – Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared null and void, such declaration of nullity shall not affect the other provisions hereof.

Section 4. Effectivity – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Chief Executive.
