**ORDINANCE No. 290, S. 2017**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 211, S. 2013.**

**Whereas**, Municipal Ordinance No. 211, S. 2013 was enacted purposely to increase the amount given by the Municipality to its component barangays by way of assistance/subsidy from FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP40,000.00) per barangay per annum as mandated by then Municipal Ordinance No. 103, S. 2006, to the prevailing FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP50,000.00) per barangay per annum;

**Whereas**, Ordinance No. 211, S. 2013, also identifies the source of funding for said barangay assistance/subsidy to be from the Twenty Percent (20%) Municipal Development Fund, thus, making the utilization of the barangay assistance/subsidy covered by the same limitations on the utilization of the Twenty Percent Municipal Development Fund. In sum, utilization for the barangay assistance/subsidy was relegated merely for infrastructure purposes, foreclosing other more practical uses;

**Whereas**, it is also observed that the Fifty Thousand Pesos Annual Barangay Assistance/Subsidy, if used for infrastructure projects is usually insufficient for said purposes;

**Whereas**, there is a need to enact an ordinance with the end in view of making the utilization of the Annual Barangay Assistance/Subsidy more flexible and not limited to its present usage for infrastructure projects;

**WHEREFORE**, this body, after considering the foregoing premises hereto decrees the following:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT-** Section 2 of Municipal Ordinance No. 211, S. of 2013 is hereby amended to read as follows-

*"SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 3 of Municipal Ordinance No. 103, S. 2006, are hereto amended to read as follows:*

*'Section 3. ALLOCATION – There is hereby automatically appropriated the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP800,000.00) from the General Fund of the Municipal General Annual Fund Budget, effective Calendar Year 2014 and every*

*succeeding year thereafter as subsidy or financial assistance to the sixteen (16) barangay governments of Bontoc, Mountain Province.<sup>1</sup>*

*Sec. 3.1. The sixteen (16) barangay governments shall be entitled to an equal share from the foregoing appropriations in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP50,000.00) per year. This amount shall be used exclusively for operational expenses and other purposes. The barangay government, before expenditure, shall allocate said funds through an appropriation ordinance.<sup>2</sup>*

*Sec. 3.2. This barangay assistance/subsidy is hereto declared a primary consideration in the Municipal General Annual Fund Budget and the inclusion in the budget or the appropriation thereof shall never be subject to the availability of funds.*

*Sec. 3.3. The failure of the Local Chief Executive to provide such amount in the Municipal General Annual Fund Budget shall subject him to appropriate administrative penalties as provided for in the Local Government Code and other applicable laws.<sup>3</sup>*

**Section 2. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All pertinent provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 211, S. 2013, Municipal Ordinance No. 103, s. 2006, as well as any and all other Ordinances, Resolution and Issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.


**Section 3. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2018.
