ORDINANCE NO. 301, S.2018

AN ORDINANCE OPENING ONE HUNDRED (100) ADDITIONAL TRICYCLE FRANCHISES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.

EXPLANATORY

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code (RA7160) provides:
"Section 16. General Welfare. Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and support among other things. **Promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort of their inhabitants;**"

WHEREAS, Section 446 of the Local Government Code (RA7160) also provides:
"Section 447. Powers, duties, functions and compensation, (3) Subject to the provisions of Book II of this code, enact ordinances granting franchises and authorizing the issuance of permits or licenses upon such conditions and for such purposes intended to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality and pursuant to this legislative authority shall: (iv) **regulate the operation of tricycles and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality;**

WHEREAS, the unsystematic operation of tricycle owners/operators without valid franchises poses a threat to the security and comfort of the riding public.

WHEREFORE, in order to prevent and ensure the organized business of the operators/owners, there is a need to increase/open tricycle franchises to accommodate the clamor.

NOWHEREFORE AND CONSIDERING THE FOREGOING, this august body, duly assembled, decrees the following:

PAGE 2, ORDINANCE NO. 301, S. 2018, AN ORDINANCE OPENING ONE HUNDRED (100) ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE

SECTION 1. OPENING - In addition to those already existing awarded franchises, there is hereto opened/created another one hundred (100) new tricycle franchises for this municipality.

SECTION 2. PROHIBITED ACTS - No operator/owner is issued a tricycle franchise without presenting/designating a garage for the tricycle. The issuance of tricycle franchise carries with it the reciprocal obligation of operator/owners to comply with the rules and regulations set by the Municipal Tricycle Franchise and Regulatory Board (MTRFB).

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZATION - For purposes of this ordinance, the Local Chief Executive is authorized to initiate the case before the honorable courts of jurisdiction, for the violation of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY - Any provision or part hereof that are inconsistent to existing laws, rules and regulations, shall be deemed repealed.


SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall take effect after due publication in the news bulletin and newspaper of general circulation in the Municipality of Bontoc, Mountain Province.
