**ORDINANCE NO. 304, S.2018**

Sponsor: Hon. Julian F. Chumacog

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PREVENTION, CONTROL, REDUCTION AND MITIGATION OF THE MOSQUITO VECTOR OF DENGUE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC.**

**WHEREAS**, based on the record, dengue cases continue to increase causing an alarming public health problem;

**WHEREAS**, dengue is a community based problem and that there is need to intensify community awareness and participation to successfully minimize or eradicate the vector and the disease;

**WHEREAS**, dengue remains a major cause of mortality and morbidity in our country. All regions, cities and municipalities are endemic for dengue and Bontoc is not spared to experience such as outbreak or epidemic;

**WHEREAS**, considering that dengue is a vector-borne disease transmitted by an infected mosquito, produced in any artificial containers that hold clear stagnant water, dengue will spread easily;

**WHEREAS**, at present, the only method of controlling or preventing dengue virus transmission is to combat the vector mosquitoes;

**WHEREAS**, vector control could be effectively and efficiently implemented using environmental management and chemical methods as well as proper solid waste disposal and improved water storage practices, including covering containers to prevent access by egg-laying female mosquito.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE ENACTED AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BONTOC, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** - This ordinance shall be known as the "Anti-Dengue Vector Ordinance."

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. - As used in the Ordinance, the following term

2.1 Dengue - an acute infectious disease caused by a flavivirus (species Dengue virus of the genus Flavivirus), transmitted by aedes mosquitoes and characterized by headache, severe joint pain, and rash- also called break bone fever, dengue fever.

2.2 Stagnant Water - motionless water, not flowing in a stream or current, also known as standing water.

2.3 Public Places/Establishment - hotels, dormitories, lodging and boarding tenement houses, apartels, hospitals, libraries, museums, offices, malls, markets, supermarkets movie houses and other similar institutions.

2.4 Vector - an organism that can carry a particular disease-causing agent (like a virus) without actually developing the disease.

2.5 Place - land, building, residence, pier, watercraft or any means of conveyance.

2.6 Public Places - parks, plazas, picnic grounds, camps, roads, cemeteries and memorial parks, terminals, rest areas, and other open fields and enclosed areas of public assembly.

2.7 Integrated Control - controlling pests through the use of several different methods and procedures which are used to complement each other. These procedures may include the use of pesticides, environmental sanitation measures, natural as well as mechanical and biological control methods.

2.8 Pesticides - any substances or product, or mixture intended to control, prevent destroy, repel or mitigate, directly or indirectly any pest.

2.9 Fumigation - the act of applying, releasing or dispensing a toxic chemical so that it reaches the target organism primarily or wholly in gaseous state.

SECTION 3. All owners, managers, administrators and/or care takers of households, schools, vacant lots, abandoned houses, tire trading/merchandise business, and all other building/establishments within Bontoc are mandated to get rid of vector breeding ground, particularly stagnant water, to avoid mosquito larvae (kiti-kiti), otherwise they are presumed to have violated this ordinance.

Minimum Requirements for Compliance:

- a) Building structures under construction must not accumulate stagnant water and solid wastes.
- b) Water drums, pails, similar containers must be covered at all times.
- c) Old or discarded tires should be punctured or cut.
- d) Unused tin cans, jars, bottles, pots, and the like should be properly collected, stored, or disposed
- e) Gutters of roof must be maintained free from accumulation of rain water.
- f) Abandoned swimming pools must be treated with larvicides or other means of controlling the vectors.

- g) Uninhabited structures/buildings must be free from all kinds of waste.
- h) All plant vases and pots, open bamboo poles, free holes, leaf plant axils, other natural or artificial containers that may accumulate water, should always be checked as the potential breeding place of Aedes Aegypti Mosquitoes.

**SECTION 4. PREVENTION AND CONTROL**

- 4.1 All other interventions especially the use of chemicals other than for research purposes shall secure clearance from the Municipal Health Office prior to it conduct.
- 4.2 The MHO shall have to approve the abatement program for the elimination of the vector.
- 4.3 Pest control operators shall have to register or be accredited by the Municipal Health Office (MHO) prior to the render of services within the jurisdiction of Bontoc, Mountain Province.
- 4.4 All new technologies, approaches and processes that may be developed in the future which will help in the prevention and control of dengue shall be adopted for implementation.

**SECTION 5. INFORMATION EDUCATION CAMPAIGN (IEC)** - The Municipal Health Office with the cooperation of Municipal Environmental and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), Liga ng mga Barangay and the barangay concerned shall conduct a massive public awareness campaign - which include but not limited to health education including the organization/coordination and lectures, Ovi-Larvitrapping, manner of destroying breeding sites, and participation in the "Oplan Linis Activities" - as well as disseminate all information relative to the implementation of this ordinance.

**SECTION 6. CREATION OF ANTI-DENGUE TASK FORCE AND DEPUTATION OF ENFORCERS**

An Anti-Dengue Task Force shall be created and organized which shall implement the program. Likewise, it shall monitor and implementation and enforcement of this ordinance; oversee and enforce strict implementation of the clean-up drive; coordinate with agencies or offices concerned relative to the information and awareness campaign against dengue; and create Dengue Monitoring and prevention Team which will be primarily responsible for the monitoring of the incidence of dengue in 16 barangays in Bontoc and submission of a monthly report anent data collected on dengue cases in the barangays to the Anti-Dengue Task Force and Municipal Health. An orientation shall be conducted by the Municipal Health Office and Municipal Legal Office for the enforcers of this ordinance and their names shall later be endorsed by the Municipal Health Office to the Municipal Mayor for deputation.

**SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** - If any provision or part of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions thereof shall remain valid and effective.

**SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE** - All ordinances, orders or rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
