ORDINANCE NO. 315, S. 2019
(SPONSORED BY HON. ALSANNYSTER F. PATINGAN)

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE LAST FRIDAY OF SEPTEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS OFFICIAL TEACHER'S DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

Whereas, Proclamation No. 242, issued in during the administration of His Excellency Benigno Simeon C. Aquino III, had declared the period of September 5 to October 5 of every year as "National Teacher's Month";

Whereas, the Local Government Unit of Bontoc, Mountain Province, hereto recognizes the importance and indispensability of the teaching profession in rearing the youth and preparing them for their future. Each teacher is a catalyst in the transfer of knowledge and wisdom through the generations, thus, ensuring that future generations are sufficiently informed of the lessons learned from the past;

Whereas, this Body in recognition of the importance of all teachers, particularly those serving in this jurisdiction, hereto enacts this Ordinance formally establishing that definite day of the year where it will pay its respect, extend its gratitude and bestows honor upon these members of the noblest of all the professions;

NOW THEREFORE, THIS BODY HERETO DECREES THE FOLLOWING:

Section 1. SHORT TITLE- This Ordinance shall be known as the "MUNICIPAL TEACHER'S DAY ORDINANCE OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE";

Section 2. POLICY- It is hereto declared the policy of this Municipality to establish that specific day of the year for the celebration of the "Teacher's Day", where the teachers serving in its jurisdiction are hereto recognized and honored. Further, the setting of a specific date is for the intent of synchronizing all activities relative to such event under a specific time and period.

Section 3. OFFICIAL TEACHER'S DAY- The official "TEACHER'S DAY" in the Municipality of Bontoc, Mountain Province, is hereto set on the last Friday of the Month of September of each and every year.

Section 4. TEACHER'S DAY COMMITTEE AND FUNCTIONS-

a) **COMMITTEE** – The Office of the District Supervisor of the Department of Education, shall designate the members of the Teacher's Day Committee within a reasonable time of two (2) months before the last Friday of September of each year and submit the list to the Office of the Municipal Mayor for his concurrence.

-The Municipal Mayor shall assign his representative to the said committee who, along with the Sangguniang Bayan Committee Chairman on Education, shall be mandatory representatives of the said Committee;

b) **FUNCTIONS** – The Teacher's Day Committee shall have the following functions:

1. To prepare and recommend for approval of the Municipal Mayor the programs and guidelines of activities for the Teacher's Day within a period of at least two (2) weeks prior to the said date;
2. To inform within a reasonable time all schools and other concerned offices of the program of activities of the Teacher's Day;
3. To inform the Municipal Mayor and the Sangguniang Bayan within a reasonable time prior to the activities of the different awardees/honorees on the said event; and
4. To perform such other functions as may be assigned by the Municipal Mayor.


Section 5. TEACHER'S DAY ACTIVITIES- The approved programs and activities shall be conducted on the last Friday of September of every year which has been hereto established as the official "TEACHER'S DAY" in the Municipality.


Section 6. RECOGNITION- As much as practicable, the Local Government Unit shall make sure that all awardees and honorees are properly recognized and feted during the activities with plaques/certificates of recognition/appreciation/commendation or other minor tokens conveying the Municipality's recognition of said honorees/awardees.


Section 7. APPROPRIATIONS- The Local Government Unit shall appropriate an amount of SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP60,000.00) annually as its financial contribution to defray the costs relative to the conduct of the Municipal Teacher's Day.

Section 8. SEPARABILITY- If for any reason a section or sections of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected shall hereto continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 9. REPEALING CLAUSE- All ordinances, rules, and regulations or parts thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent hereto are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 10. EFFECTIVITY- This Ordinance shall come into effect on 01 January 2020, provided it successfully hurdles the review process before the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.
