ORDINANCE NO. 321, S. 2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TITLE AS WELL AS SECTIONS 2 AND 4 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 263, SERIES OF 2015, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "MUNICIPAL HEALTH CARE ORDINANCE OF 2015".

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 263, S. 2015 otherwise known as the "MUNICIPAL HEALTH CARE ORDINANCE OF 2015" was enacted by this August Body as a form of benefit for elected and appointed employees of the Municipal Government;

WHEREAS and however, casual observation show that the said benefit is underutilized for several factors such as the specific and limited time for availment and to a certain extent the limited subjects targeted for such benefits; and

WHEREAS and so as not to render the said ordinance useless, this Body hereto decrees these amendments to the foregoing ordinance with the hopes that the same may finally render the said Ordinance viable for the purpose for which it was initially intended – to keep the Municipal Workforce healthy to enable them to render optimal service to the constituents.

WHEREFORE AND UNDER THE FOREGOING PREMISES, this Body now decrees the following:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.

1a. AMENDMENT OF TITLE: So as to render the Ordinance specific as to the subjects thereto, the TITLE of Municipal Ordinance No. 263, S. 2015, is hereto amended **from:** "MUNICIPAL HEALTH CARE ORDINANCE OF 2015", **to "MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES HEALTH CARE ORDINANCE OF 2015".**



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1b. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 2: The provision of Section 2 which reads, *"The medical check-up program shall be granted to all permanent and elected personnel of the Local Government unit of Bontoc."* is amended to read and be implemented as follows: **"The medical check-up program shall be granted to all permanent and elected personnel of the Local Government unit of Bontoc"**. The same benefits shall also be available to casual and job-order employees when applicable, as when they celebrate their birthdays while still in the service of the Municipality."

1c. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 4: Due to some inherent inability of some subject beneficiaries to utilize the said benefits due to its specific and limited date of availability, Section 4 of the said ordinance which states, *"The annual medical check-up shall be availed by the employee on the day of their birthday and if the birthday falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be on the next regular working day."* is hereto amended to read as follows: **"The annual medical check-up shall be availed of by the employee on any day of their birth month"**.

SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY. Any part, portion or provision of this Ordinance, found inconsistent with law shall only nullify such provision/s specifically affected.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. All previous Ordinance/Resolutions of the Sangguniang Bayan, including executive issuances enacted for purposes of implementation thereof are hereto repealed and modified to conform hereto upon effectivity of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon signature of the Local Chief Executive.
