MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO.325,S.2020

REVISED EMERGENCY RELIEF ASSISTANCE TO DISASTER ORDINANCE OF 2020

Sponsor: Hon. Jerome B. Tudlong Jr.

Explanatory Note

Despite the level of preparedness by the Local Government Unit of Bontoc, Mountain Province and other government agencies, still damage to life and property may still occur due to disasters both man made and natural.

To expedite the early recovery and rehabilitation of families affected due to man-made and/or natural disasters there is a need to provide immediate relief and rehabilitation assistance to victims of disasters.

SECTION 1. The municipality of Bontoc shall provide relief and rehabilitation assistance to victims of disasters.

SECTION II. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a) Victim - a person harmed, injured or killed as a result of a disaster.
- b) Disaster - a sudden event, cause by a natural or man made catastrophe, that causes damage or loss of life.
- c) Relief/Burial - assistance especially in the form of money, given to those in special need or difficulty.
- d) Rehabilitation/shelter - the action of restoring something that has been damaged to its former condition.

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SECTION III. The assistance shall be as follows :

1. Relief/Burial Assistance
 - a) The family of the victim who died due to disaster will receive Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00.)
 - b) Victims who are injured due to disaster and needs hospital care will receive five thousand pesos (P5,000.00).
 - c) Should the victim be missing, the family shall be given P2,000.00 per day for three (3) days, if still missing on the 5th day the family shall be given the balance to complete the amount of P10,000.00.
2. Rehabilitation/Shelter Assistance
 - a) The owner of the house shall receive Twenty Thousand pesos (P20,000.00) as an emergency shelter assistance for totally damaged residential houses, and eight thousand pesos (P8,000.00) for totally damaged house, shanties and cottages.
 - b) Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) for partially damaged residential houses.

SECTION 1V. The requirements for the release of Relief/Burial assistance and rehabilitation/Shelter assistance as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance are the following;

1. Philippine National Police (PNP) Bureau of Fire (BFP) blotter
2. Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management (MDRRM) Office report/certificate.
3. Additional requirements for the Relief Assistance
 - a) Death certificate issued by the Local Civil Registrar when applicable.
 - b) Medical certificate issued by the Municipal Health Office if applicable.
3. Additional requirements for Rehabilitation/ Shelter
4. Assistance
 - a) Barangay certification as to ownership of the house
 - b) Barangay certification of boarders residing in the house totally damaged.

SECTION V. The amount of Two Hundred Thousand (P200,000.00) shall annually be appropriated from the General Fund and re-allocating the funds for Relief /Burial Assistance and Rehabilitation/Shelter assistance under the Special Purpose Fund to form part of the total allocation. The Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P200,000.00) is broken down as follows:



SECTION VI. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - Any provisions of this ordinance declared as unconstitutional or contrary to the law by the competent court shall not affect the validity of the other provisions not declared invalid.
