MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 329.S.2021

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE DISPOSITION OF THE FUNDS COLLECTED FROM MEDICAL AND TRAVEL PASS ISSUED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.

Explanatory Note

Part of precautionary measure for the prevention/mitigation of COVID-19 cases within the municipality has been collecting fees for issuance of Travel Pass and Health Declaration Pass to those individuals travelling outside the municipality of Bontoc. This is under the principle lifeblood doctrine under taxation laws, furthermore the Local Government Code provides that the Local Government Units are allowed to create its own sources of Revenue to augment the meager funds of the national treasury. Section 129 of the Local Government Code of 1991, to wit: "Each Local Government Unit shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees and charges subject to the provisions herein, consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy. Such taxes shall accrue exclusively to the Local Government Units."

The collection of fee for Travel Pass and Health Declaration Pass being authorized under our Municipal Revenue Code which took effect last January 2020 however was not crafted within the purview of the existence of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

In this regard, there is a need to create a trust fund specifically for COVID Programs from the fees that are being collected in the issuance of Travel Pass and Health Declaration Pass.


NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bontoc assembled that;





Page 2 of Ordinance No. 329,S.2021 - AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE DISPOSITION OF THE FUNDS COLLECTED FROM MEDICAL AND TRAVEL PASS ISSUED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.

SECTION 1: The municipality of Bontoc shall provide a trust fund for COVID Programs which shall be taken from funds/fees collected from the issuance of Travel Pass and Health Declaration Pass;

SECTION 2: DEFINITION OF TERM:

1. Health Pass - Health declaration pass/forms issued for travel purposes only .
2. Travel Pass - For travel authority issued for travel purposes only.
3. COVID Programs - shall include payment of accommodation of suspected COVID patients, and/or COVID positive patients, food of frontliners, and all other programs related to COVID mitigation or prevention.

SECTION 3. SHARING OF FUNDS COLLECTED:

Forty Percent (40%) of fees/funds collected from travel pass and health pass shall be deposited and used for COVID Programs. The municipality is mandated to create a trust fund for this purpose.

The remaining Sixty Percent (60%) of the fees/funds collected shall form part of the general funds of the municipality.

SECTION 4: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE:


The parts and provision of this ordinance are separable, if any part or provisions hereof is declared invalid by competent authority, the other parts or provisions hereof not invalid shall remain in full force and full effect.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVITY:

All collections from the issuance of Travel Pass and Health Declaration Pass collected from January 4,2021 shall be covered by this ordinance.
