AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE GREEN POLICE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

P R E F A T O R Y

Whereas, since 2013, the Municipality had been employing the services of the Green Police as a complement to the Municipality's regular personnel dealing with the collection and segregation of the town's waste as well as preparation for its transport to the Municipal Waste Processing Facility;

Whereas, the necessity and benefits of continuing this program had been well taken and there is a need to ensure its continuity, thus, the need to institutionalize the same to formally effect its existence and secure its continuity as a tool for the Municipality in addressing its waste management issues; thus-

Wherefore and under the foregoing premises, this Body hereto decrees the following:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be referred to as the "FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO GREEN POLICE ORDINANCE".

Section 2. Scope. Upon effectivity, this ordinance shall apply to all existing members of the Green Police as well as those subsequently appointed thereto.


Section 3. Financial Assistance. The members of the Green Police shall be entitled to a financial assistance of One Thousand and Five Hundred Pesos (PHP1,500.00) per month subject to the usual accounting requirements as may be imposed.


Section 4. Delegated Authority to Increase. The Local Chief Executive is hereto authorized to increase, but not to decrease, the Financial Assistance provided for under the immediately preceding section through the proper Executive Order, should the need arise.



without going through the cumbersome process of amendment of this ordinance just for purposes of increasing the said Financial Aid.

Section 5. Provisions. As much as possible and when the finances of the Municipality allow, the Local Chief Executive shall likewise provide to members of the Green Police the necessary gears being provided to the regular personnel of the MENR Office such as but not limited to boots, gloves, rain coats, etc.

Section 6. Funding. The Local Chief Executive shall ensure the provision in the Annual General Fund Budget of sufficient funds for the implementation of this ordinance.

Section 7. Repealing Clause. This Ordinance hereto repeals all Ordinances, Resolutions, Orders or other Issuances inconsistent hereto.

Section 8. Separability. In any event any provision of this Ordinance is declared unlawful or unconstitutional by the proper courts, the same shall not affect such other provisions not so declared.

Section 9. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect on 01 January 2022, regardless of the date of signing by the Local Chief Executive or the date of approval on review by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.
