**ORDINANCE NO. 359, S. 2022**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN INCREASE IN THE TRICYCLE FARE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE, REPEALING THEREOF ORDINANCE NO. 213, SERIES OF 2013 AND FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 128, SERIES OF 2008, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, The existing minimum tricycle fare in this municipality is nine pesos (Php. 9.00) and seven pesos (Php.7.00) for students, senior citizens and differently-abled individuals respectively, as provided for in Ordinance No. 213, series of 2013;

**WHEREAS**, Municipal Ordinance No. 213 amended sections 1(a) and 2 of Ordinance No. 128, series of 2008 specifically concerning the provisions of the minimum tricycle fare;

**WHEREAS**, a petition for a fare increase was submitted by the members of the Bontoc Federated Association of Tricycle Operators and Drivers (BOFATOD) to the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of this municipality citing among the reasons the soaring prices of fuels, spare parts for maintenance of their respective units as well as the increase value of the basic necessities;

**WHEREAS**, accordingly the existing tricycle fare rate barely yields an income on the part of the tricycle drivers and operators for the reasons abovementioned, necessitating the review of the current minimum fare with the aim of increasing the same and upgrading their living conditions;

**FOREGOING CONSIDERED**, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bontoc, Mountain Province, in session assembled that:

**ORDINANCE NO. 359, S. 2022 - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN INCREASE IN THE TRICYCLE FARE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE, REPEALING THEREOF ORDINANCE NO. 213, SERIES OF 2013 AND FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 128, SERIES OF 2008, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**SECTION 1** – The “minimum fare” provision of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 213, series of 2013 which amended Section 1(a) of Ordinance No. 128, series of 2008 is hereby repealed and for the latter to read as follows:

- a) **REGULAR FARE** – A **THIRTEEN PESOS** (Php13.00) fare shall be charged for any tricycle travel covering any distance within the cut-off points which is less than the full and complete distance between any two (2) cut-off points specified herein.
- b) **MAXIMUM FARE** – A **FIFTEEN PESOS** (Php 15.00) fare shall be charged for any tricycle travel covering the full and complete distance between any two (2) cut-off points specified below.
  - i. On the road towards Mainit-the cut-off point is fronting the Ofo-ob building at pattig;
  - ii. On the road towards Maligcong, the cut-off point is at Ofo-ob’s residence at Sacangan/MOPRECO Compound;
  - iii. On the road towards Tocucan, the cut-off point is at the site of the old Municipal Slaughterhouse;
  - iv. On the road towards Talubin, the cut-off point is at Finew, Samoki below Yango’s residence;
  - v. On the road towards Alab, the cut-off point is at Malabong’s place at At-ato.
- c) **CONTRACT FARE** – Fares beyond the cut-off points specified above shall be by agreement of the passengers and the tricycle driver/Operator at a reasonable amount.
- d) **BAGGAGES** such as one bag cement, one sack of Rice, one sack feed and one sack fertilizer shall be charged FIVE PESOS (P5.00) each within the delineated points. Any baggage below fifty Kilos (50 Kls) is free of charge.

**SECTION 2** – Students, Senior Citizens, Differently-Abled individuals and pregnant women shall be entitled to a fixed discounted fare of **TEN PESOS** (Ph10.00).

**SECTION 3.** Children three feet and below shall be free of charge if they are accompanied.

**SECTION 4 – FARE MATRIX** – The official document for the MTFRB that serves as a guide to passengers about the mandated fare within specified four (4) central barangay zonal limits of Bontoc issued in consonance with Executive Order No. 05, S. 2022 by the Honorable Mayor, Franklin C. Odsey having reference with the latest tricycle fare adjustment issued only to legally qualified tricycle operators owing to Municipal Tax Ordinance No. 316, S. 2020, shall be surrendered with the MTFRB and replaced with a new fare matrix that is in accordance with this ordinance but shall not be required any additional fee to the effect.
