**ORDINANCE No. 356, S. '2022**  
*Sponsor: Hon. ESTEBAN O. NGUDDO*

**UPGRADING THE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY GRADE POSITION OF ELECTIVE POSITIONS AS MAYOR II, SG-28, MUNICIPAL VICE MAYOR II, SG-26; AND ELEVEN (11) POSITIONS OF SANGGUNIANG BAYAN MEMBERS II, SG-25 FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONTOC, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE.**

**WHEREAS**, cognizant of the need for effective local governance, maximum salary rates of elective officials shall equate them to CESO ranks or higher to enable them to attain or develop their fullest capacity in dedicated service to their constituents;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 81, RA 7160, the compensation of local government officials and employees shall be determined by the sanggunian concerned provided that: . . . the increase in compensation of elective local government officials shall take effect only after the terms of office of those approving such increase shall have expired;

**WHEREAS**, clearly in the above premise, it is understood thus that, the local sanggunian is empowered to determine positions, salaries and wages, allowances and other benefits of officials and employees paid wholly or mainly from local government funds;

**WHEREAS**, elective positions serve a full term of only three (3) years and it is befitting that officials who hold any of the positions by virtue of the provisions of the constitution, being honorable person of a community who are given the mandate of the people, shall bear a distinction apart from appointive officials;

WHEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT ENACTED by this sanggunian THAT:

Section 1. Upgrading of Salary Grade Positions of Elective Positions

The Salary grade positions of elective positions will be:

One(1) position of Mayor II	SG-28
One(1) position of Vice Mayor II	SG-26
Eleven (11) positions of Sangguniang Bayan Member II	SG-25



Section 2. Assent of Abolition – shall the existing positions of Mayor, Vice mayor, and regular and ex-officio positions of Sangguniang Bayan Members be vacated or declared vacant by virtue of position reclassification and upgrading same shall then be reckoned abolished;

Section 3. Application – the upgrading of the classification and salary grade positions of elective positions and ex-officio members shall take effect only after the term of office of those approving such increase have already expired (Sec. 81, Local Government Code)- for regular members; mayor, vice mayor, and regular sangguniang bayan members after the May 2022 elections and for ex-officio members after the election/ selection of next sets of ex-officio members;

Section 4. Authority to Transfer Appropriation – the upgrading of the classification and salary grade- positions under Section 1 of this ordinance are not civil service positions and shall in anyway required to be subscribed by the commission (CSC) under its laws on positions; and for this sake, the positions posted for contest in which candidates were filed for the 2022 elections are: Mayor, Vice Mayor, and eleven (11) positions of Sangguniang Bayan Member, for the case of municipalities outside of Metro Manila and in this instance, upgrading of the position after assumption to any of the elected posts is not restrained by civil service procedures with the official undergoing the personnel selection board; thereby, upon submission of application to the Provincial Governor, and after being sworn to office to any of the new ranks (created positions by this ordinance), the appropriation shall automatically be deemed transferred.

Increment in the appropriations for the new salary rates, allowances, and other emoluments shall be determined by the local finance committee, this municipality and provided in the CY 2022 general fund annual budget.

Section 5. Effectivity – This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Local Chief Executive; the implementation of which however, shall be after the conclusion of the CY 2022 national election.
